Pursuant to Ohio Fire Code section 307 (Open Burning, Recreational Fires and Portable Outdoor Fireplaces), 307.2 and 307.2.1, to receive a burn permit from the Fire Department you must submit this Application(s), the Approval Letter(s)/Permit from the Ohio EPA, a sketch of the burn location and a \$25.00 payment to the Fire Department with each application, at least five (5) days before the fire is to be set. The Toledo Division of Environmental Services (TDOES) is the contractual agent for the Ohio EPA that enforces Ohio open burning regulations throughout Lucas County. Contact them at 419-936-3015 to determine if your project requires a permit. The EPA application must be submitted to them at least ten (10) days before the fire is to be set. Both the person conducting the burning and the owner of the property must sign the Ohio EPA permit application. Both parties are legally responsible for the burning.

Checks or money orders should be made payable to the **SYLVANIA TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT.** If paying in person, cash, check or money order is acceptable.

Permit applications may be submitted in person weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., (Monday thru Friday) or mailed to: Sylvania Township Fire Department, Firehouse No. 64, 8210 Sylvania Avenue, Sylvania, OH 43560.
